In some cases -- particularly for state-owned oil and gas companies -- we use production data from the Oil & Gas Journal in its OGI150 and OGI100.
Crude production includes natural gas liquids (NGL) unless noted.

Natural gas is typically reported as dry gas; natural gas liquids are reported under crude oil.
Carbon dioxide is normally removed from the gas flow at the production site (see "Vented Carbon Dioxide").
"SCM/d" = standard cubic meters per day. "cf/d" = cubic feet per day.

Anadarko and ARCO Alaska discover the Alpine Field near the Colville River on the North Slope in 1994; signs explor agreement in Eritrea and discover two fields in Indonesia in 1995; Mobil alliance 1997; strengthens North Slope position; 2000 Anadarko merges with Union Pacific Resources, solidifying its position as one of the largest and most successful independent exploration and production companies in the world. The combination doubles Anadarko's proved reserves; 2001 Anadarko completes the \$1 billion acquisition of Canadian-based Berkely Petroleum Corporation; 2002 Anadarko acquires Howell Corporation, which includes the Wyoming Salt Creek field -- one of the largest remaining enhanced oil recovery opportunities in the Lower 48. The Howell acquisition is the cornerstone of a much larger effort to expand Anadarko's oil production in Wyoming.
We attribute Union Pacific and Berkely Petroleum production to Anadarko; Howell's production is minor.
